The exhibition "Women in Ibero-America" presents a diversity of perspectives and sensitivities that focus on the diverse reality of the immense geographical area covered by Ibero-American culture. The countries that are part of the sample are Andorra, Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Ecuador, El Salvador, Spain, Honduras, Mexico, Panama, Peru, Portugal, Dominican Republic and Uruguay, with the participation of 35 photographs of 25 artists. In the words of its founder, Juanita Guerra: "Each stitch we make in Juanita's sewing kit is threaded into the heart of Colombia, it is our roots that give us that unique touch of authenticity."
