

Latin American literature in Austria

Juan Gabriel Vásquez, from Bogotá, is one of the most important contemporary narrators in Latin America. Vásquez achieved international success with his novel The Informers, Riverhead Books, (2013).

His literary work has been published in 16 languages, and has been awarded with the Alfaguara de Novela, the International IMPAC Dublin Literary Award, the Gregor von Rezzori Award, the Vargas Llosa Award, among others.

The Embassy of Colombia in Austria, the Lateinamerikaforschung Austria, Austrian PEN Club and the Weltmuseum Wien have invited Juan Gabriel Vásquez to Austria to speak about his works in April.






