
Cultural News Colombia

ARS electronica RECOMMENDED OF festival

The city of Linz will welcome artists, scientists and interested visitors from around the globe to the Ars Electronic 2023 Festival, which will take place from September 6 to 10, 2023. This year, the theme revolves around the ownership of truth, and through exhibitions, screenings and projections, it is hoped to create an ideal environment to encourage reflection.

This year is a memorable one for Colombia, because it enjoys an excellent representation in Austria. Among the group of winners are: Andres Gaviria with his project 0.0 and Rosemberg Sandoval with The artist's room in Bahareque won the CIFO Award; Ana Maria Gomez with Inoclate will receive CIFO x Ars Electronica Award; Alba Triana with Harmonic Motion will receive the Award of Distinction. and finally the Atractor collective with the story of two seeds will receive the Golden Nica, the marked award.

The Story of Two Seeds: Sound and Silence in the Andean Plains of Latin America, shows the interaction of the amaranth seed and the transgenic soybean seed with the earth and the elements that surround it, through the interpretation of sound waves.







Bleeding blue RECOMMENDED OF THE MONTH

Colombian Natalia Domínguez Rangel presented at the Alpbach 2023 Forum in Tyrol Austria, the art installation "Bleeding blue", which seeks to make visible the problem of ocean noise pollution and its harmful effects on marine life.



The Alpbach European Forum brings together stakeholders from around the world to discuss politics, business, culture and science that will subsequently help catapult Europe and the rest of the planet in these areas. Specifically, the artwork was located in one of the bathrooms of the Alpbach Congress Center. Upon entering the visitor can listen to audio recorded by multiple scientists and marine biologists that capture the intrusion of humans into the underwater environment. The purpose is to create a juxtaposition between the serene sound of the ocean and the impact of noise production from the thousands of activities performed by humans on marine life.

The call to conscience that Natalia makes through this installation is avant-garde, as it provokes an exchange of role in humans, subjecting them to the thousands of noises that she traces representatively on the bathroom mirror so that they experience and understand the harmfulness of the issue and proceed imminently.


